SOLAR INSTALLATIONS SLATED FOR TWO MINNEAPOLIS FACILITIES

March 21, 2011

MINNEAPOLIS, MN – The City of Minneapolis has recently awarded Minnesota-based [Westwood Professional Services, Inc.](#) (Westwood) design contracts for two rooftop photovoltaic (PV) solar projects with a total capacity of 140kW. These projects are funded by the Solar America Cities grant which was awarded to both Minneapolis and St. Paul to support the Cities' efforts to make solar energy more accessible for homes and businesses.

The two systems will be perched atop the roofs of the Royalston Maintenance Facility (100kW) and Currie Equipment Facility (40kW) in Minneapolis. Westwood will act as the owner's representative, providing program management services including design & engineering, construction management and commissioning of the solar energy systems.

Project design has begun and the project is planned for completion on the summer of 2011. Westwood completed the Minneapolis Convention Center Rooftop Solar Project in November and has several additional solar installations underway in Minnesota.
